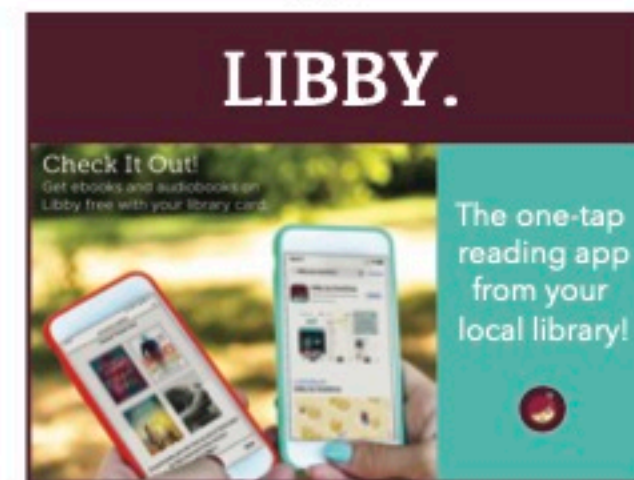
### ALZHEIMER'S AWARENESS SERIES
