Last year, supporters like you raised more than \$12,000 for virtual services, new online resources, and locker systems throughout the counties.

In 2019-2020, the Missouri River Regional Library system was able to expand library services in Osage County by moving into a new facility that more than doubled the size of the former facility. More space for programs, collections, and public meetings is now a reality. The Main Library in downtown Jefferson City is in the same position the Osage County Branch was in a few years ago and has outgrown its current space. By adding a 3rd floor and building an addition on the High Street side, the Library can gain much needed space for programs, collections, and public meetings while addressing critical building issues that included outdated elevators, limited technology infrastructure, and restrooms that barely meet ADA standards.
