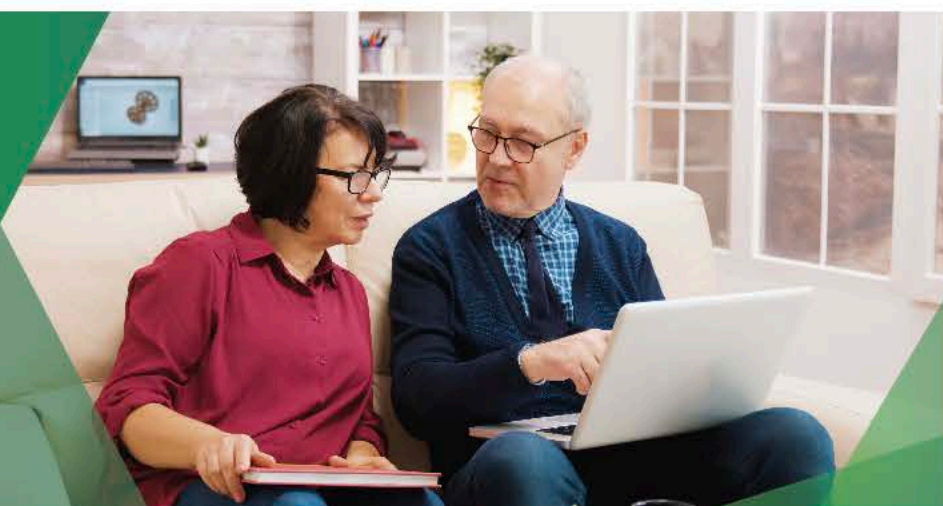

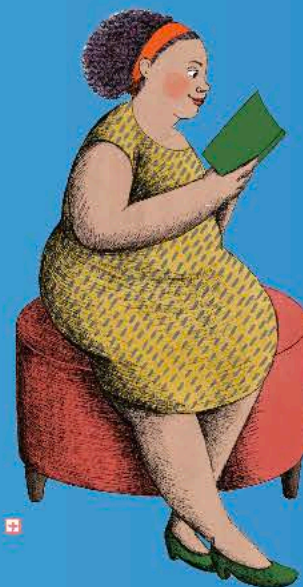

Please bring the following documents: ID, Social Security card, proof of income, copy of lease/bills, etc.

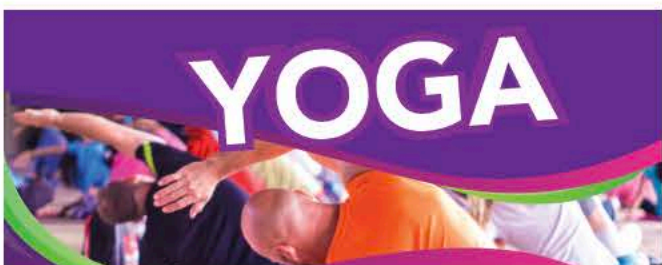

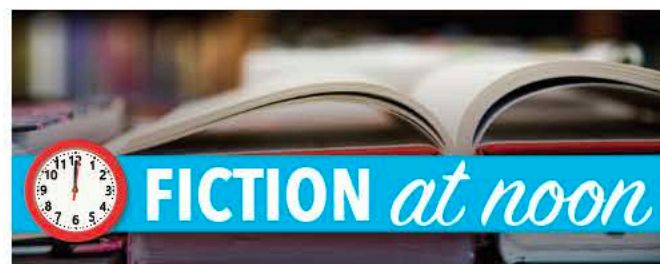
