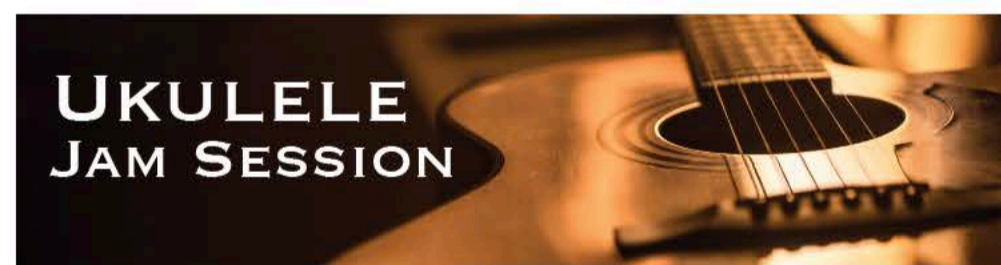
RECEPTION FOR OCHS & OCAC PHOTOGRAPHERS
