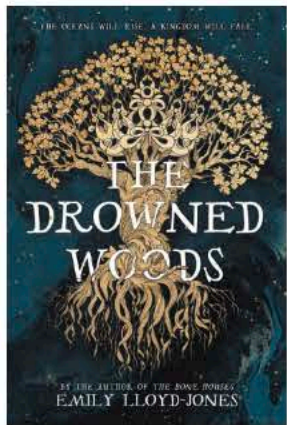

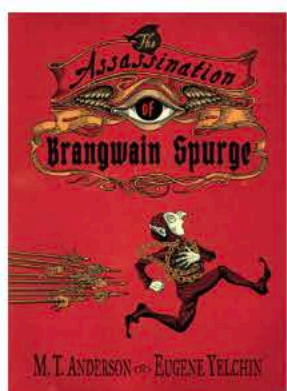
TEEN MOVIE NIGHT: *THE BALLAD OF SONGBIRDS AND SNAKES*
