## LEGOS & LOGS BUILDING PARTY

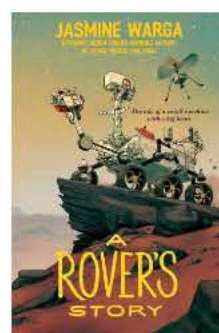

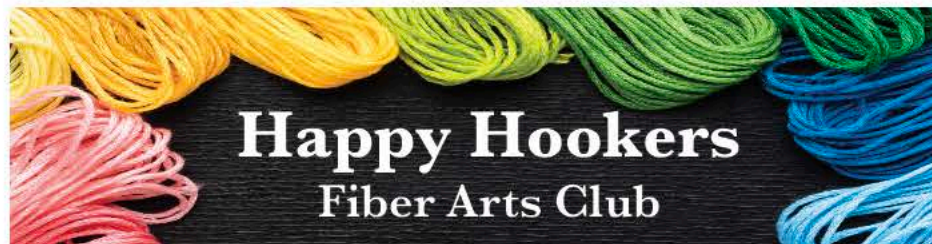
