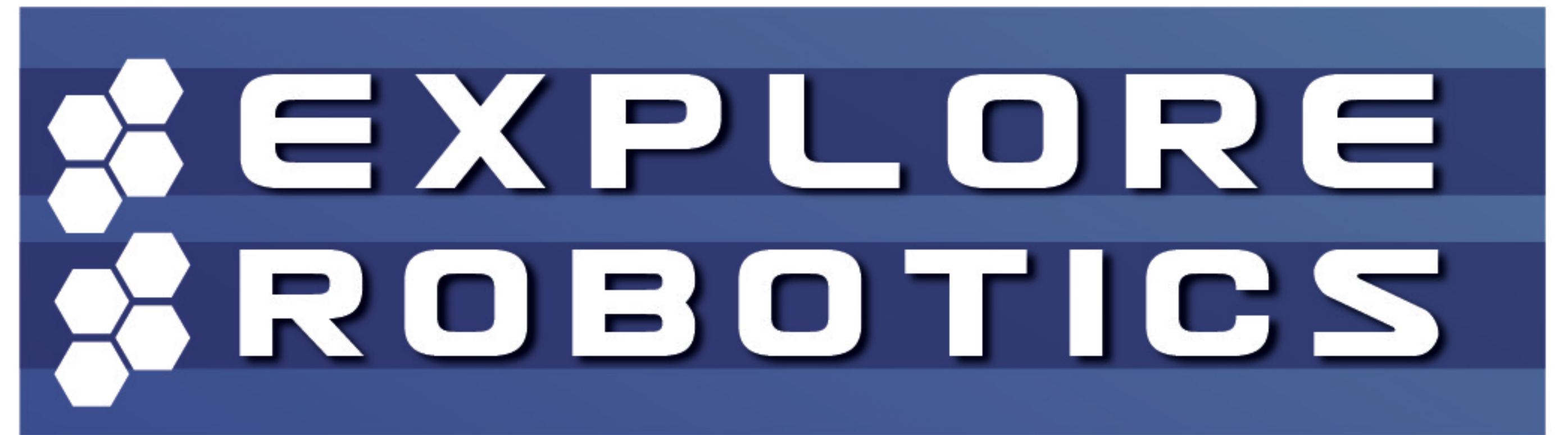

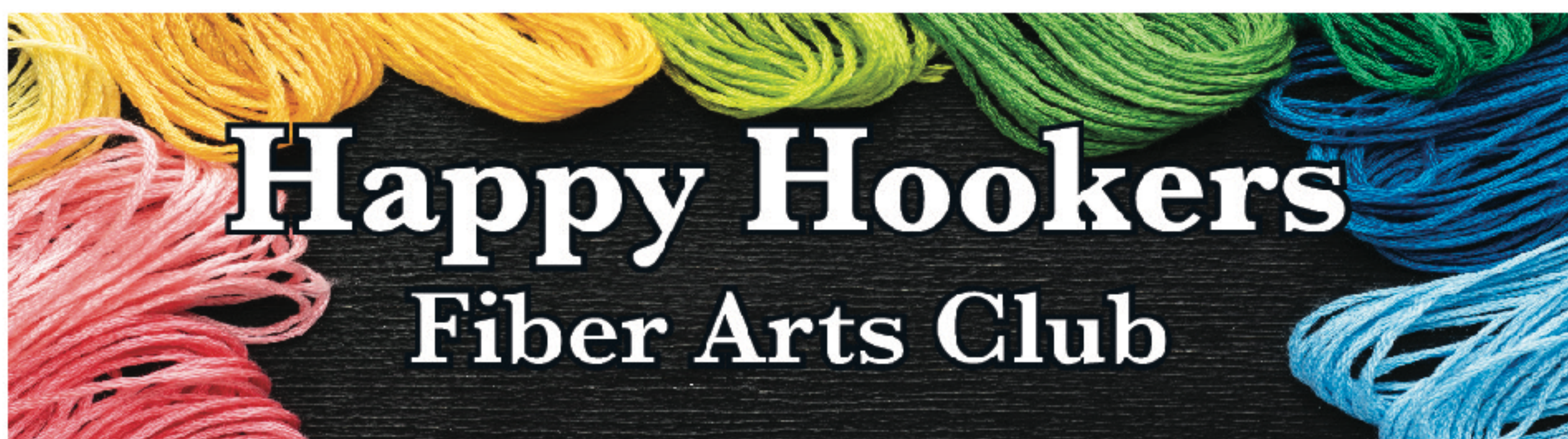
EXPLORE ROBOTICS
