## Family Movie Night: "The LEGO Batman Movie" (PG)

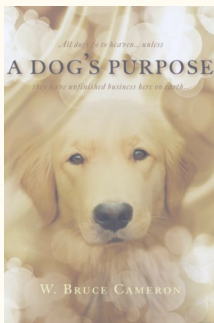
